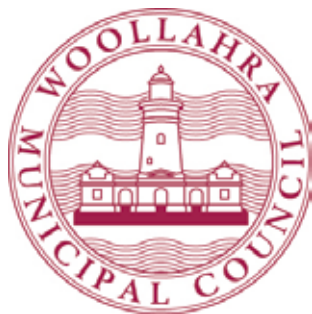

Community Transport



Community Transport at Holdsworth

Community Transport provides affordable, accessible transport to eligible residents of Woollahra unable to access public transport or without access to private vehicle support. Mobility and transport can be a major issue for people who are frail, isolated or have disabilities and this service can provide vital links to the community and a range of essential services.

The Centre operates a number of buses as well as station wagons for individual transport. We have experienced drivers, staff and volunteers to ensure a safe and responsive service.

Holdsworth welcomes diversity and does not discriminate against anyone on any grounds.

For many of our services we ask for a contribution towards our costs; however, services will never be refused because of an inability to pay.

Shopping Buses

We have a regular Shopping Bus for people who have trouble accessing public transport. Our bus picks up clients at their door, takes them to one of the local shopping centres and drops them off at home afterwards.

Individual Transport

An individual transport service is available from Monday to Friday, 8.30am to 5.30pm for medical, dental and physiotherapy appointments.

The individual transport service is available Saturday 9.00am to 4.00pm for social appointments in the Eastern suburbs area only.

All transport requires advance booking. Please call 9302 3600 and ask for Community Transport.

In addition, the integrated approach of the Holdsworth Centre uses our extensive Community Transport Service to assist users of our many programs.

Bus Hire
