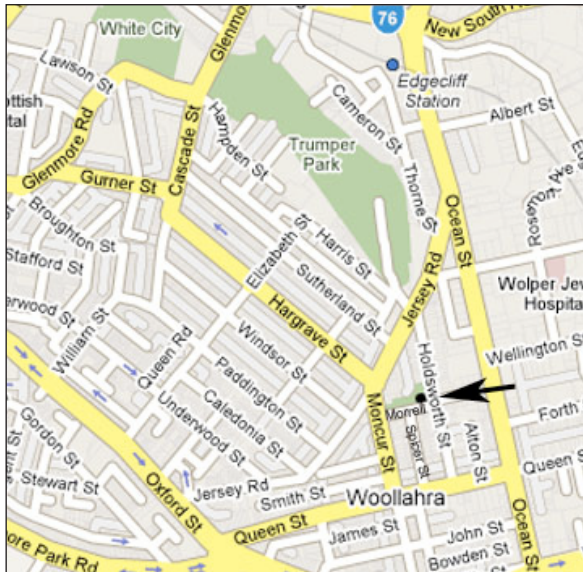

Do you need help getting around the shops?

Holdsworth Community Centre & Services has a program that can help.

Community Links Assisted Shopping Program (CLASP)

Do you need a friendly arm to hold on to? Do you have a visual impairment and can't read the labels? Do you have trouble holding on to the shopping trolley and picking items from the shelf at the same time? Is the bottom shelf too low and the top shelf too high?

The Community Links Assisted Shopping Program links a volunteer with someone who wants to go shopping but requires extra assistance and friendly support. This would be a regular arrangement, once a week, fortnight or month, not an ad hoc service. The time and day of the week will be determined by your wishes and the availability of the volunteer.

The volunteer would meet you at your home, travel with you to whichever shops or shopping centre you wish to go to and then come back with you to your home. Usually, this would take up to two hours.

If you want to do grocery shopping, the volunteer will only carry up to two bags for you. If there are more than two bags, you would have to use the store's home delivery service for which there is a charge.

Unfortunately our volunteers cannot take on people who are confined to a wheelchair.

There is no charge made for the volunteer, however, you will be responsible for travel costs to and from the shops.

Other Shopping Services

Individual Shopping Service
Holdsworth Community Centre & Services provides a friendly and personal home shopping service for people in the community who cannot do their own shopping. We offer a regular weekly or fortnightly service designed to accommodate your individual needs and requirements. Our aim is to assist you with your regular shopping needs with a minimum of fuss.

Shopping Buses

We have a regular Shopping Bus for people who have difficulty accessing public transport but who can do their own shopping. Our bus picks up clients at their door, takes them to one of the local shopping centres and drops them off at home afterwards. Help is provided to carry shopping into the home.
